Brief Description of the target groups	<p>The target group comes from representatives of three cities – Polish Nakło nad Notecią, Slovenian Naklo and Czech Náklo. These are residents of the above-mentioned partner cities, wanted to establish contacts with foreign partners, open to exchanging knowledge and views on functioning in the structures of the European Union. The project beneficiaries included adults, but the most prominent representation was made up of youth coming from all three locations mentioned.</p> <p>What is extremely important, the project participants come from different countries and cities. These cities (Polish Nakło nad Notecią, Slovenian Naklo and Czech Náklo) are of different sizes, but in none of the mentioned cases are they large urban agglomerations. We are talking about small towns, distant from large cities - where similar opportunities for meetings with peers are much more limited. By participating in the project, each participant was able to learn more about the fundamental values and functioning of the European Union and express their views by participating in discussions and debates. The implementation of this international mobility also gave the project participants and the local community the opportunity to strengthen cooperation at the cross-border level.</p> <p>Me, the Citizen of the European Union as the leading theme of the project also aimed to make citizens of the European Union aware of their rights, obligations and common values regarding the structure of the European Union. During the meeting, the participants exchanged their individual experiences and observations, and shared their knowledge about the functioning of democratic mechanisms in each countries.</p> <p>21.02.2025 preparatory meeting on-line via zoom. 03.03.2025 – DAY 1: Arrival. Meeting of the partners (welcome dinner).</p> <p>04.03.2025 – DAY 2: Youth workshop: Me, the Citizen of European Union/visit to the Slovenian Parliament The first day of second mobility started at 10:30 a.m. at Biotehniški center Naklo, Strahinj 99 with a ceremonial welcome of the participants by the project staff and the Slovenian hosts and local authorities from Naklo. From 11 a.m participants took part in workshops that were divided into two parts: integration and discussion. The topic of the workshop “A sense of citizenship in the EU” allowed participants to gain knowledge and express their opinions on the rights and obligations of a European Union citizen. The second part of workshop took place at the Slovenian parliament with participation of the president of the National Council Marko Lotrič.</p> <p>05.03.2025 – DAY 3: Open Space for Europe debate and quiz. At 10 a.m., the Open-space meeting began at Biotehniški center Naklo, Strahinj. The event was attended by both project participants and students from the local high school. It concerned the topic of mobility: A sense of citizenship in the EU. Due to weather conditions, it was held in the school hall. At the end, all participants took part of a quiz, testing knowledge of the European Union, which was won by a group of three female students from the Polish Naklo. Just before lunch the young participants, divided into four groups, also took part in sports, music, painting and cooking workshops, the aim of which was to integrate the group and later present their achievements during the cultural event.</p> <p>06.03.2025 – DAY 4: Cultural event/festival (departure). On the last day of mobility, at 9 a.m., preparations for the cultural and historical event began at the Janež Filipič Cultural Centre. Event started one hour later at 10 am. The ceremony was honored with his presence of Ivan Meglič, mayor of the Obcina Naklo commune and member of the National Council. In the first part of the event, project participants had the opportunity to</p>

	<p>present the skills acquired during the thematic workshops of the previous day.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - local dishes from all three countries were served to the audience. - and works of art made using traditional Slovenian methods were presented to the audience. - The choir sang songs from Slovenia, the Czech Republic and Poland. <p>At the end, the participants sang "Ode to joy" together in Slovenian and English.</p> <p>In the second part of the cultural and historical event, the Slovenian hosts introduced the participants to the local cultural heritage through performances by local folk groups.</p> <p>After dinner and an official farewell, the Polish and Czech groups set off on their way back home.</p>
